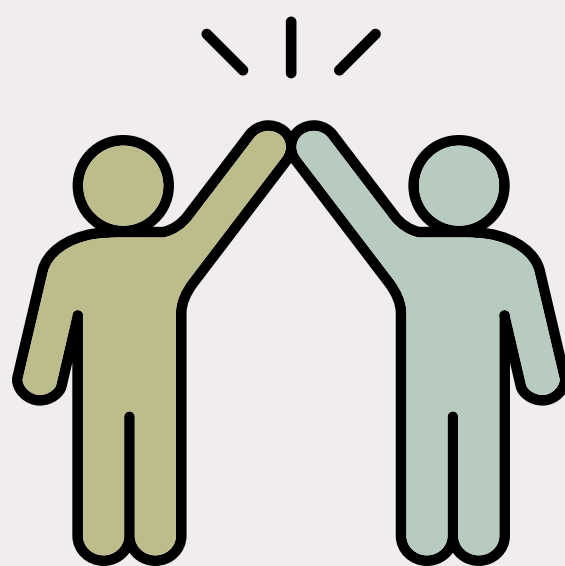
## IS YOUR CHILD A VOLUNTEERING HERO?

What was your favourite childhood book?

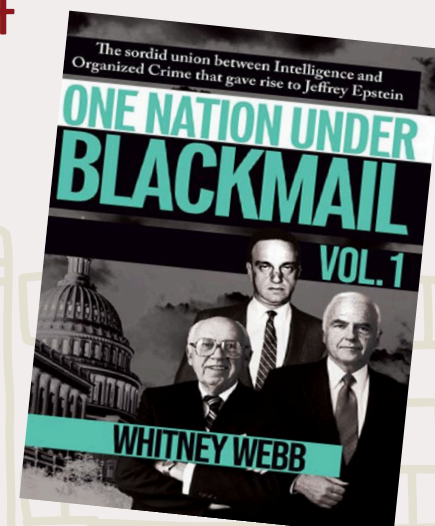
The Stand by Stephen King was my favourite childhood book.

What have you read recently that you enjoyed?

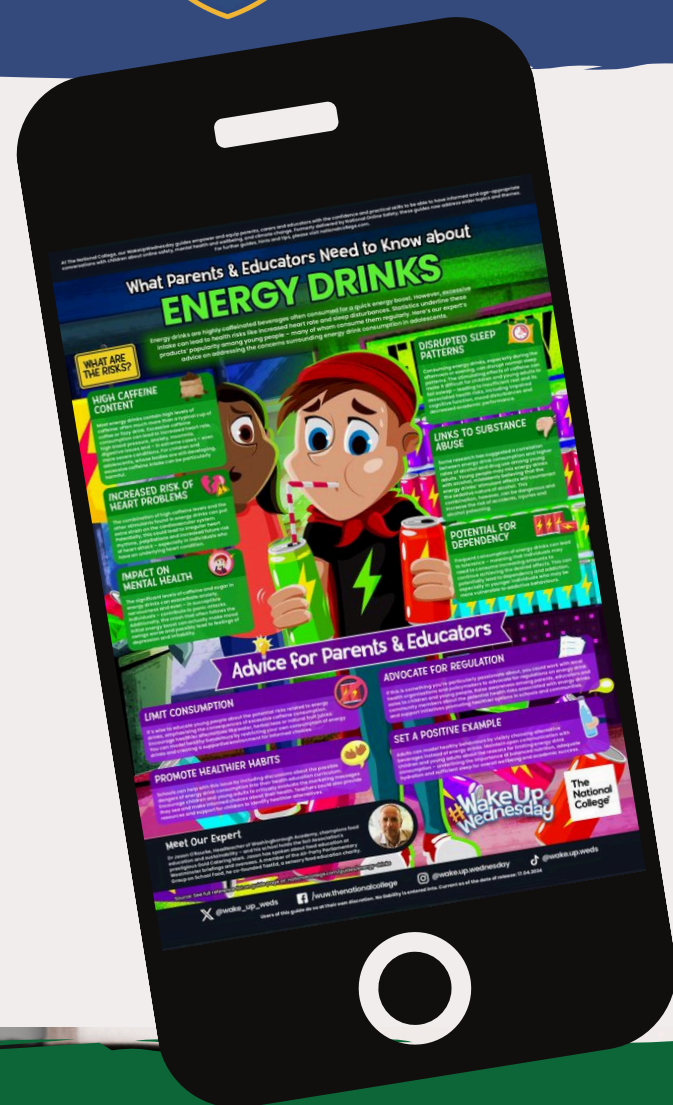
One Nation Under Blackmail by Whitney Webb a very interesting history of the relationship between organised crime and the government and big business.
