

#### **COUNTLESS OPPORTUNITIES TO SHINE**

We are a school of character - we encourage our students to get involved in the many clubs, teams and school trips which we offer, to enrich their experiences and help them in honing the skills needed to move into the wider world. Various sports teams represent our school, some at national level; musical opportunities are frequent, with talent shows, musicals, choirs and bands; and there is a diverse array of clubs with academic, skills-based, sporting and character-building offerings.

Trips to Europe, linked to World War History. Alpine ski trips every February. Spanish work experience trips, where students can put to use their mature attitudes and language skills simultaneously. Theatre trips; theme park trips; sports, history and science visits. These are just some of the excursions we offer to all of our students, to allow them to observe, experience and thrive.

Uniquely, we are the only school in Kirklees with a Combined Cadet Force Unit with over 70 students currently enrolled. Cadets take part in a wide range of activities including drill training, field craft and

expeditions, first aid, and the Duke of Edinburgh Award.

Student leadership is a fundamental part of the Honley High School experience. Opportunities for developing leadership skills are available to students of all ages, with members of each year group contributing to the school's Student Council.

Led by year 11 student leaders, younger members of the school are invited to become ambassadors for their year group, representing the student body at many events throughout the academic year. Students will also be able to join our student-led working groups, tackling important issues such as the environment, cultural awareness and student wellbeing.

With other roles available such as reading leaders, numeracy leaders, sports leaders and student librarians, there is an opportunity for every member of Honley High to get involved and contribute positively to the school community.
