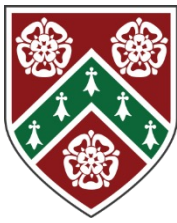

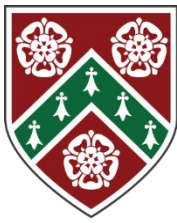

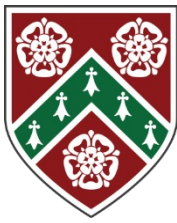

- Bring passports and EHIC cards to Student Services on Tuesday 2nd May – these will be safely stored in the school safe until we depart.

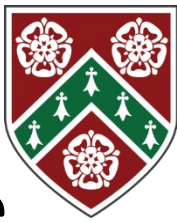


# Student Meetings

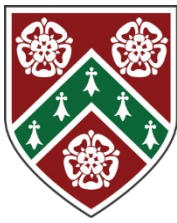

Includes one piece of checked in luggage and one piece of hand luggage:

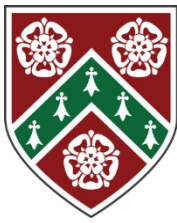




# Luggage Allowance - LIQUIDS

- Maximum of 10 x 100ml liquids in a 20 x 20cm clear, sealed bag



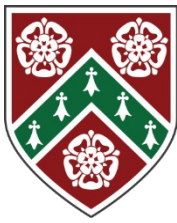


# Luggage Allowance - Electronics

- You must be able to turn on any electronic items you want to take into the cabin, so please ensure all your devices are charged before you leave home
- Items that aren't charged will need to be packed into your checked baggage and travel in the hold
- Headphones – No speakers



# What to bring ...



## Packing List

### Clothing and Accessories

- Comfortable walking shoes/trainers and one spare pair of nicer shoes for the evenings
- Shirts (short and long sleeved)
- Socks and underwear
- Jeans/trousers
- Sweatshirt/jumper
- Pyjamas
- Raincoat and sunhat/ cap ( If you wish)**
- Lightweight jacket
- Toiletries**
- Any medications (in addition to a copy of any prescription)- To be given to Mr Evans.
- Spare set of contact lenses/glasses (if wear)
- Sun cream ( essential)**

### Electronics

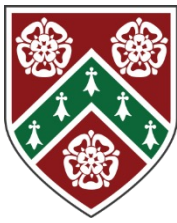
- An adaptor/converter if taking electrical equipment (phone chargers etc)
- Camera with extra batteries or chargers (batteries can be expensive abroad)

### Documents

- Passport
- Copy of any prescriptions (Customs officials may want to verify that a container's contents match its label, so all medication should be carried in its original container)

### Small day bag

- Money
- Any valuables (students are responsible for any valuables they take)
- No need to bring a towel.



# How Much Money

Students will need money in pounds sterling (£) and Polish Zloty (zł):

- Breakfast at the airport – £
- Lunch days 1, 2, and 3 -zł
- Drinks during free time/evenings - zł
- Extras from the shops - zł
- Gifts and Souvenirs - zł

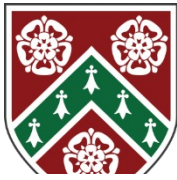
We recommend £80 in total.



# Phones

- Students will be allowed to bring their phones
- We will ask students to give us their mobile numbers so that if they are under indirect/remote supervision we can contact them
- Students will be given an emergency contact number for contacting staff if necessary
- Students should be made aware that using their phone to contact each other/home and using the internet may cost more money as they are abroad. **We recommend that students turn their data off for the duration of the trip**
- **Students are responsible for any valuables, including mobile phones, they do bring**
- **NO SPEAKERS.**

## Remember students are representing school

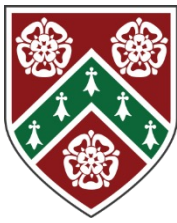
- High expectations of all students- given the nature and sensitivity of the places we are visiting.

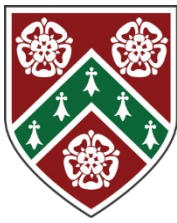
# Departure Details

- To arrive at John Paul II Balice International Airport at 11:40 am (local time)



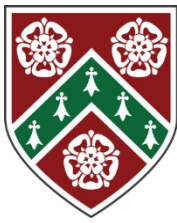
# Return Details
